Introduction

The PMU is a private university located in Al Khobar area of the Eastern Province of Saudi Arabia. The University has been established by a group of renowned individuals under the auspices of HRH Prince Mohammad Bin Fahd Bin Abdulaziz, governor of the Eastern Province.

The PMU system and academic programs were designed by an international educational consultant, Texas International Educational Consortium (TIEC), which is a consortium of 32 universities in Texas, USA. The university's system and academic programs were reviewed and verified by around 70 multinational academic/ industrial experts.



Vision

The vision of the university's founders is for it to be a unique and distinguished institution of higher education that participates in:

- Preparing future leaders in various fields of human knowledge and its application.
- Enriching and developing human intelligence.
- Exploring innovative methodologies and technologies to achieve its objectives.
- Removing the barrier between the academic and business society.

- The university's mission is to contribute to the advancement of human intelligence and promulgation and development of knowledge.
- Encourage the graduate to play a pioneering and leading role in the community, by teaching him or her how to take responsibilities and to contribute to the solving of problems through innovative thinking, collective work, reflection and self development.

Facilities

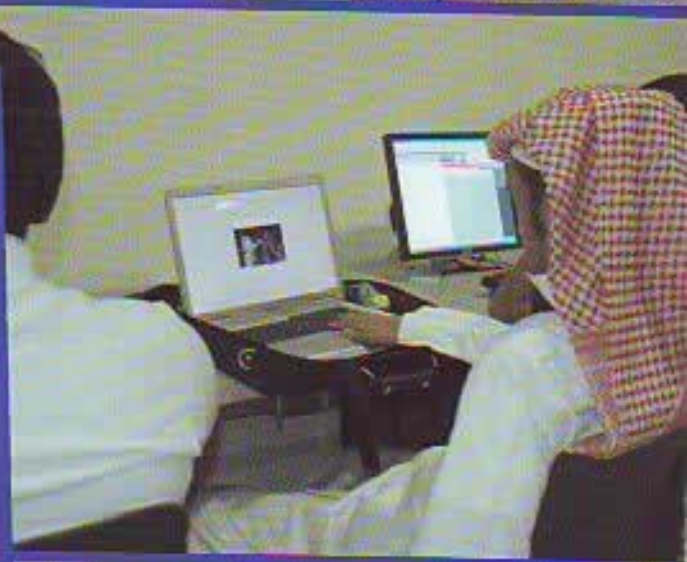


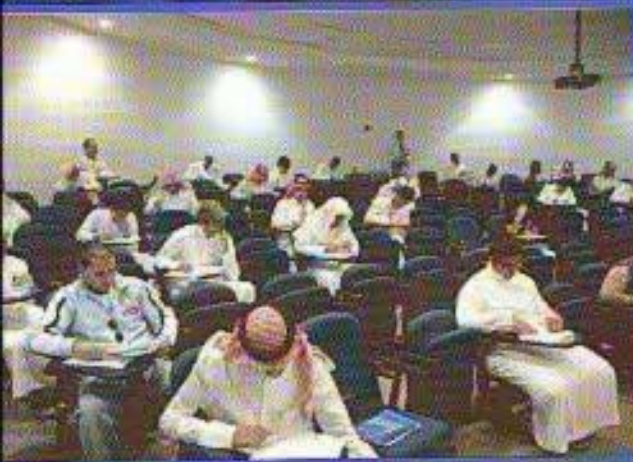


Technology

The preparatory program and the degree programs will be taught by qualified and experienced faculty instructors. English classes will be taught by natives of English speaking countries.

- A willingness to undertake professional development activities necessary to learn how to implement a student-centered, communicative classroom environment.

PMU Learning Resource Center encompasses more than a traditional library. Consistent with the emphasis on information technology, the PMU LRC offers extensive access to electronic based resources. In support of student independent learning strategies, the facility provides spaces for students to collaborate in teams on group projects, or to meet with faculty and staff for tutorials and/or small group activities.

Student Genders:

PMU admits both male and female students; however, the campus is divided into areas that maintain gender separation.

Admission Standards:

PMU maintains highly competitive admission standards as measured by an admission examination and an interview.

Size and Composition of Student Body:

PMU has a maximum total enrollment of 5,550 students with 1,110 in a non-credit, preparatory program [600 males + 510 females], and 4,440 enrolled in four-year degree programs [2,400 males + 2,040 females]. Hence, the total enrollment consists of 3,000 male and 2,550 female students.

Teamwork

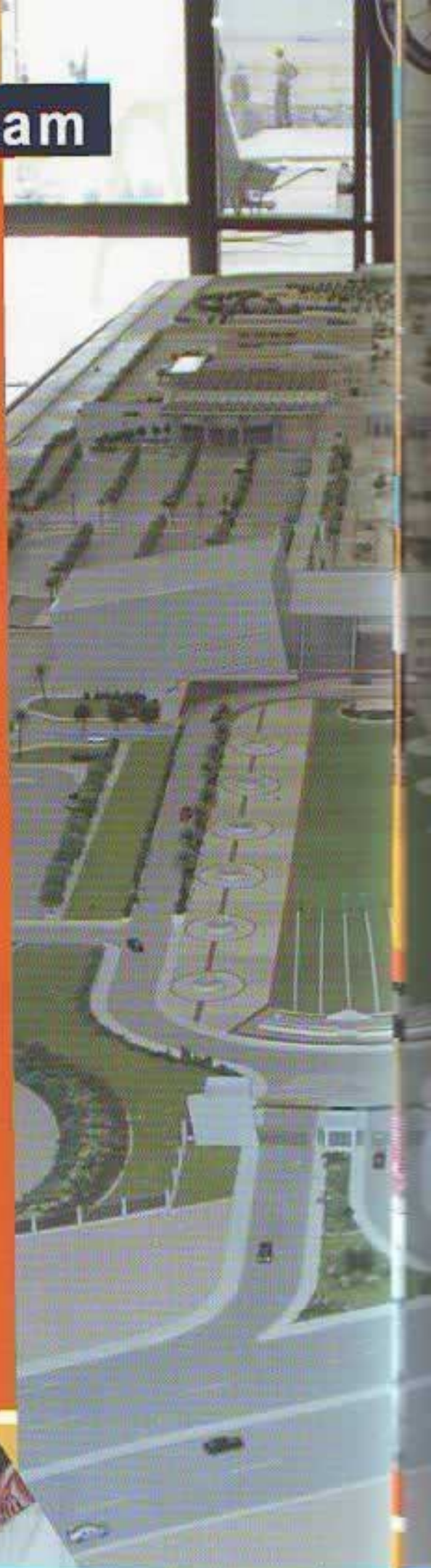
The ability to work effectively with others to accomplish tasks and achieve group goals.

The Preparatory Program

The Preparatory Program at PMU is a comprehensive, academic preparatory program, comprised of sequenced classes in English as a Foreign Language (EFL), Mathematics, and Study Skills and Learning Strategies. It strives to prepare academically capable secondary graduates to participate in university studies using the essential principles of critical thinking, reasoning, and problem solving.

1. Admission Criteria to the Preparatory Program:

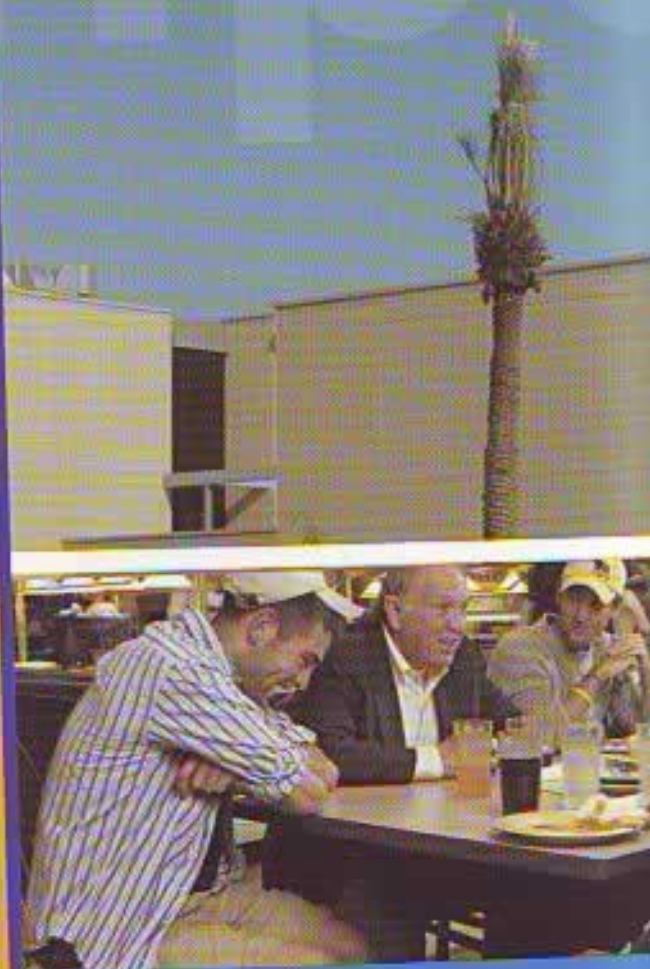
- Application form and fees.
- Overall average of 80 % on the Secondary School Certificate.
- Total score of 60 % on the Aptitude Test.
- Personal Interview.
- PMU Standard Battery Test.

2. Direct Admission to Degree Programs:

- Application form and fees.
- Overall average of 80 % on the Secondary School Certificate.
- TOEFL Score: a minimum of 510 or equivalent.

3. Transfer Students:

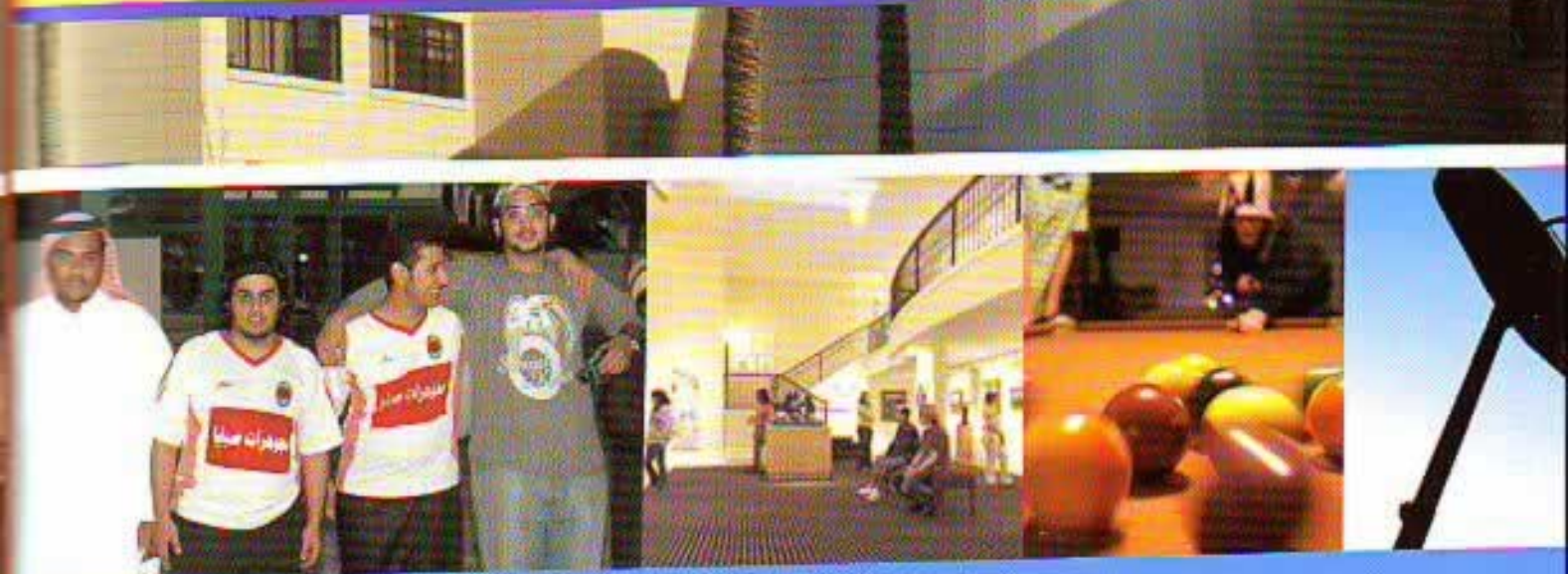
- Transfer applications are considered individually.
