The PMU System and academic programs were designed by an International Educational Consultant, Texas International Consortium (TIEC), Which is a consortium of 32 universities in Texas , USA. The university's system and academic programs were reviewed and verified by around 70 multinational academic and industrial experts.

LIBRARY SRVICES

The PMU Libraries consist of the main Library on the men's campus and the women's Library on the women's campus. The Libraries' collection is evenly divided between the two libraries.

The PMU Libraries staff is available to provide training to PMU Faculty, students, and Staff on the use of the libraries' online public access catalog (OPAC), e-Resources , as well as the print Reference collection



ACADEMIC ADVISING

The LRC Offers Academic advising services to provide students with assistance in understanding course requirements and in scheduling classes in order to be successful within the PMU's rigorous intellectual environment. The Purpose of Academic Advising services is to offer accurate and professional assistance so that every student will progress in an orderly manner toward graduation.

PMU has a maximum total enrollment of 5,550 students with 1,110 in a non – credit, preparatory program (600 males +510 females), and 4,440 enrolled in four-year degree programs (2,400 males +2,040 females). Hence the total enrollment consists of 3,000 male and 2,550 female students.

THE PREPARATORY PROGRAM

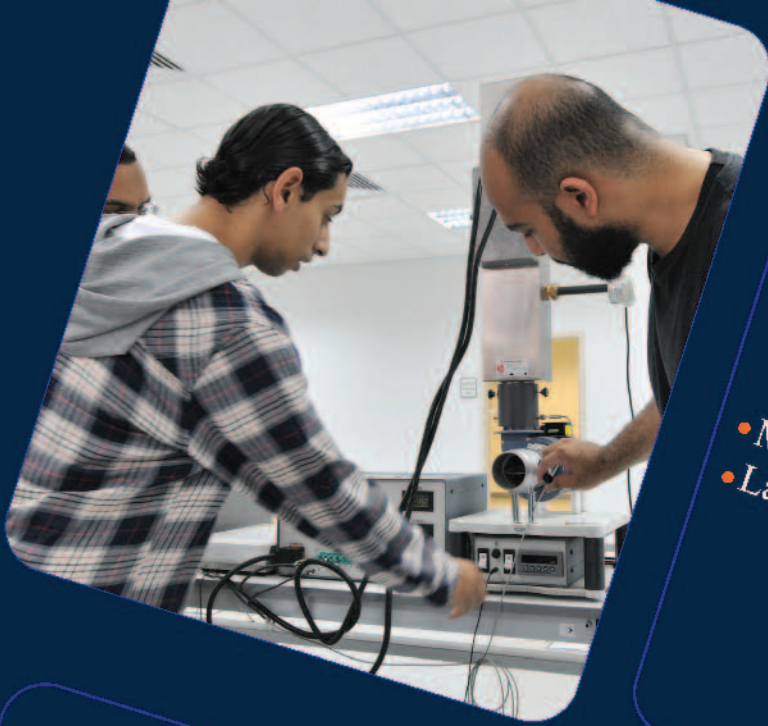
