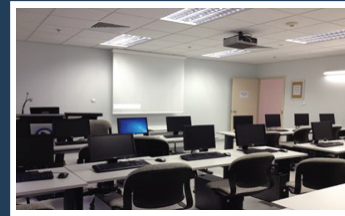

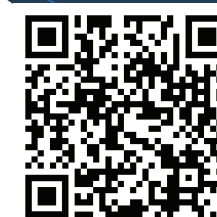

INTRODUCTION



A Degree in Accounting provides the necessary background for careers in industry and government. Career opportunities include regional and international public accounting, management accounting, taxation, financial analyst, auditor, controller, and chief financial officer. Many chief executive officers have accounting backgrounds. Accounting is the language of business and an excellent foundation for pursuing a graduate degree in accounting or other business fields.

The accounting profession qualifies professionals to engage in consulting services such as accounting information systems, personal financial planning, and investment advising.
