The College has learning facilities of highest standards: a well-equipped moot court and a legal clinic office.

WHY LAW AT PMU?

Economic and social developments, both internally and internationally, have increased the demand for legal professionals. The legal profession is also changing with a greater need for lawyers who are capable to work in international contexts and deal with relationships involving international elements.

The PMU College of Law is responsive to the changing market needs and the developments in the legal profession. The study of law at PMU is distinguished in different ways. Our BA in Law program takes a comparative approach that is founded on solid understanding of the legal system of Saudi Arabia. It is a bilingual program, taught in Arabic and English, to prepare our students to be 'international citizens' who are able to work and socially interact in an international context. The bilingual BA in Law program provides the necessary knowledge of the Saudi legal system, giving a comprehensive education covering various fields of public and private law, as well as Shariah. It also emphasizes practical knowledge and skills in order to promote the professional integration of the graduates. A new program on International Legal Studies, starting in 2022, concentrates on international trade and public international law.
