**Position Purpose:**

The chosen candidate will essentially teach courses in Education to the students in the Master and Pre-master programs.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

In addition to teaching, the responsibilities of the position include academic advising, curriculum development, selecting texts, preparing course syllabi, planning in-class team activities, constructing student assessments, preparing examinations, keeping grade records, holding regular office hours and other standard non-teaching duties such as institutional and professional services.

Two years of teaching experience at college level is preferred.
