The objectives of establishing the Global Supply Management, GSCM, Chair are listed below. All anticipated activities and measurable outcomes per year are listed in Appendix A.

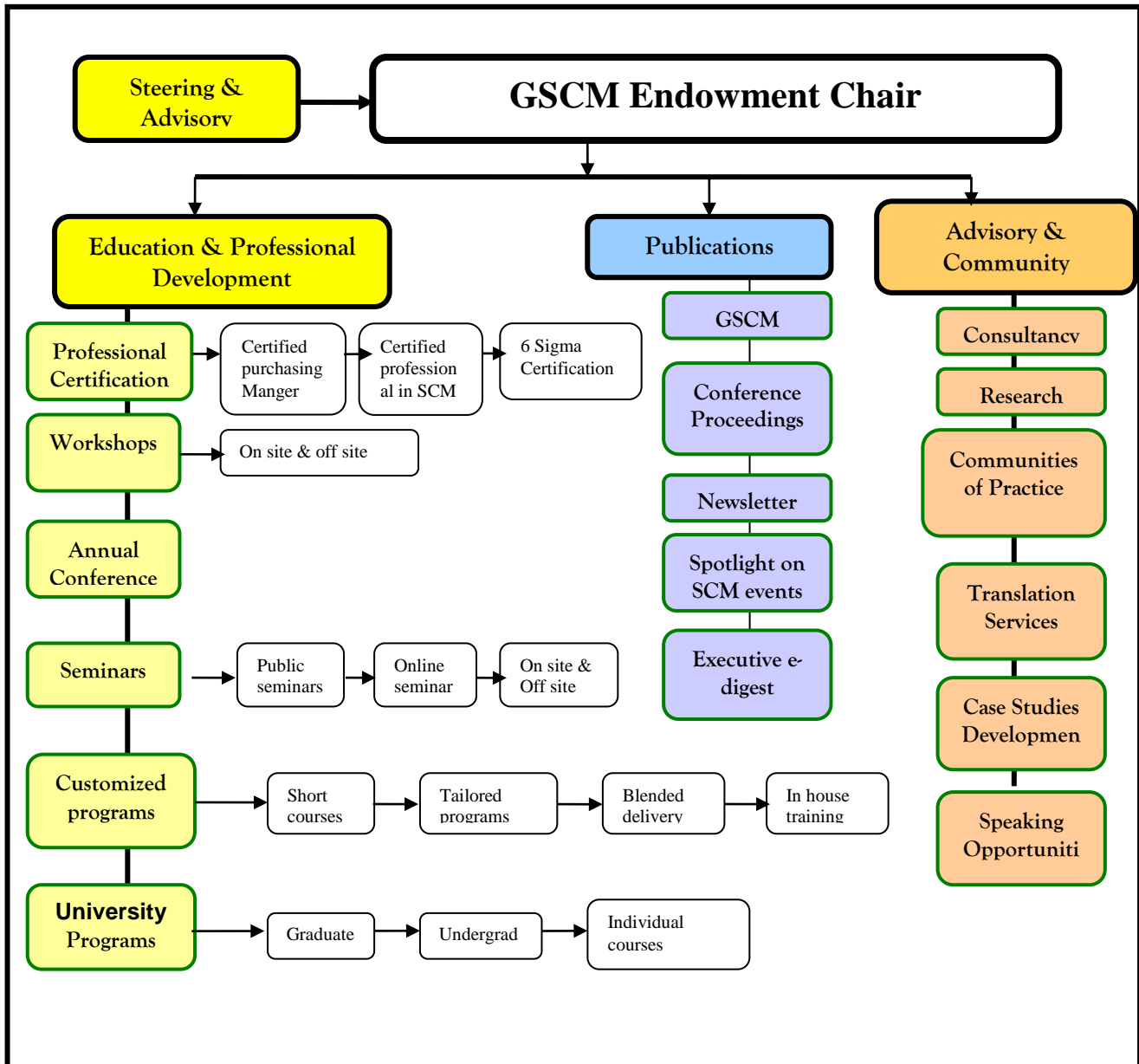
- 1.1 To identify the relevant business challenges associated with existing local supply chains, interviews with representatives from the local industry were conducted by University in addition to the literature review. Some of the identified SCM areas in Kingdom of Saudi Arabia are as follow:

  - 1.1.2 Contracting Services Procurement

  - 1.1.14 GSCM Leadership and Governance
- 1.2 To provide expertise and consulting in relevant areas of GSCM.
- 1.3 To research the existing body of knowledge in the area of maintenance/repairs/operations (MRO) and indirect materials in the GSCM, in cooperation with international academia, professional societies and other pertinent sources;
- 1.4 To assist University in developing its GSCM academic curricula.
- 1.5 To provide a platform for local universities and industry to disseminate and share knowledge in GSCM.
- 1.6 To publish and edit a journal in the field of GSCM.

- 1.7 To Organize GSCM conference every two years.
- 1.8 To organize and teach workshops and seminars in the field of GSCM in coordination with the supply chain and SAUDI ARAMCO Materials Supply.
- 1.9 To organize and conduct short courses on GSCM related topics in coordination with SAUDI ARAMCO
- 1.10 To support educational programs at University in undergraduate, postgraduate and professional certifications.
- 1.11 To establish a newsletter aimed at disseminating new trends and knowledge.
- 1.12 To mentor and support University's college of business faculty in the publication of their work in world class journals.
- 1.13 To provide guidance to Saudi industrial sectors engaged in global logistics.

#### **APPOINTMENT OF THE GSCM CHAIR**

- 2.1 The University shall recommend the GSCM Chair candidate, either from within University staff or outside of University staff. The final selection and appointment of the GSCM Chair professor shall be by mutual agreement between the University and SAUDI ARAMCO.
- 2.2 The GSCM Chair candidate should possess the following qualifications:
  - 2.2.1 Education (Baccalaureate, Masters and Doctorate) from accredited universities acceptable to both parties
  - 2.2.2 Significant experience in teaching and research at an internationally recognized university acceptable to both parties and the title of a full professor at an institution of higher learning acceptable to both parties
  - 2.2.3 Author of scholarly or business publications related to supply chain management in journals with global distribution
  - 2.2.4 Editor of a world class journal published by an internationally recognized publisher
  - 2.2.5 President/CEO of a global organization (preferred but not a must)
  - 2.2.6 Rich and varied consulting experience across the world
  - 2.2.7 Global leadership evident in the form of participating and organizing international conferences
