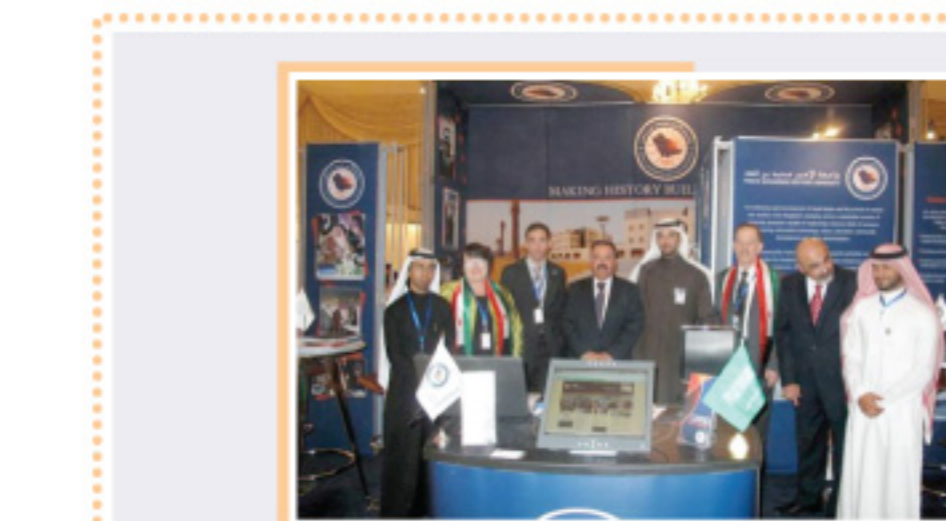

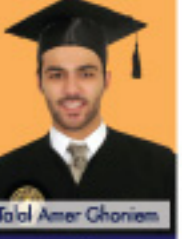
## Sports Centre Opening

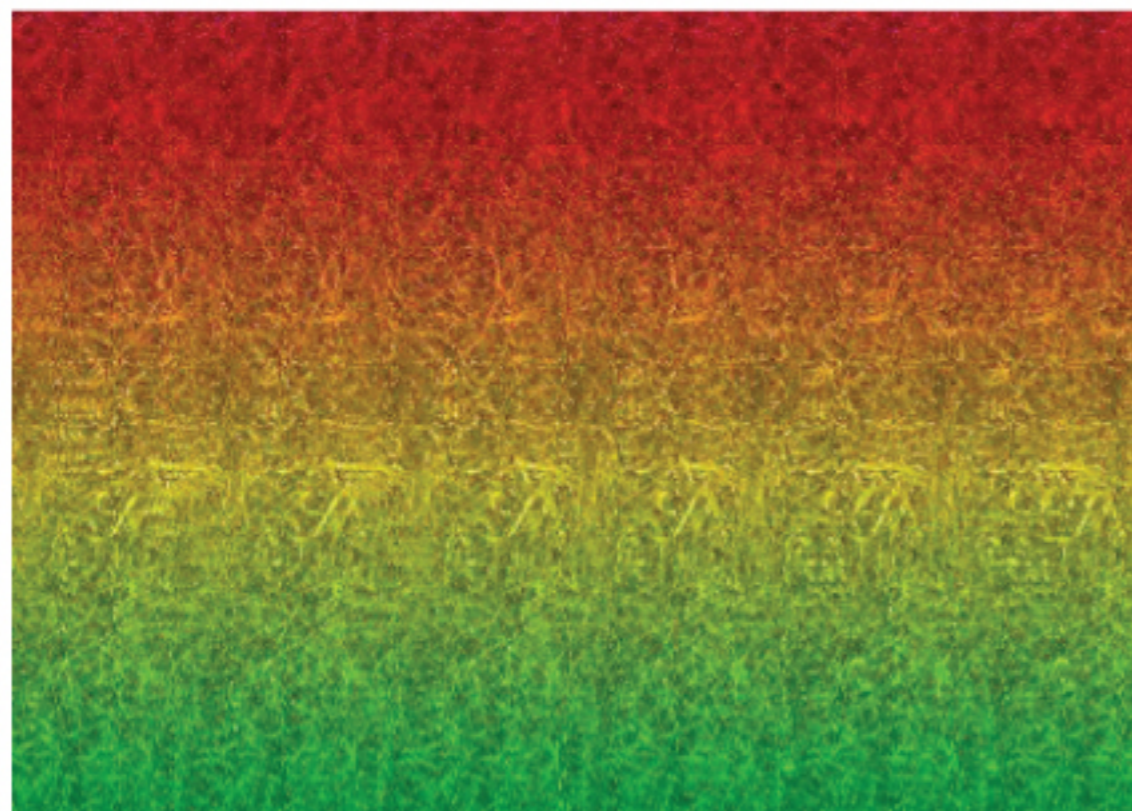
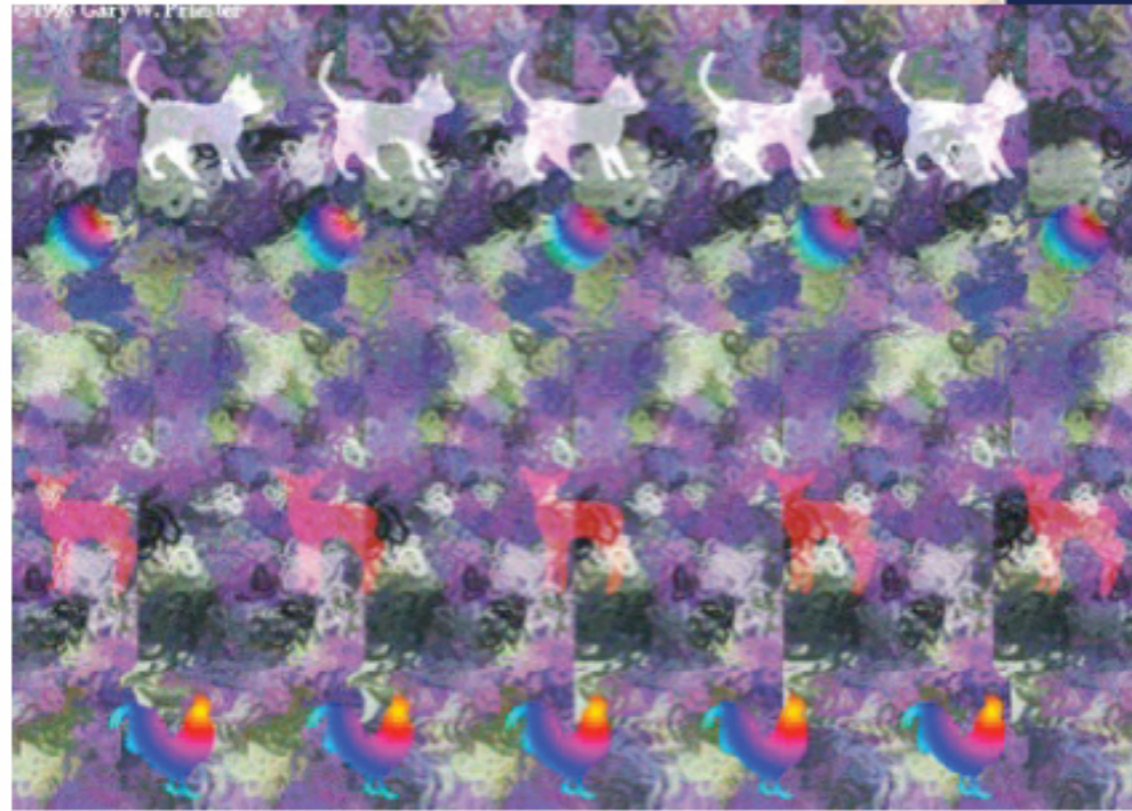

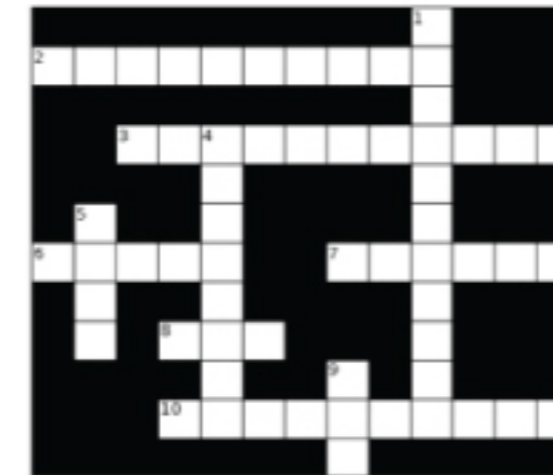

A brief report

It all started in the Fall semester 2010, when our instructor Mr. Ahmed Hussain of the Introduction to Engineering course assigned his students to think of a new and unique project idea that can solve a particular problem and significant enough to be implemented in the Saudi Arabian society. We were thinking to design a translation device for Hajj pilgrims when our instructor Mr. Ahmed suggested the idea of Hajj Kiosk Terminal to help lost pilgrims find their way to their camps in Mina in addition to a host of other services. We liked this idea very much and called it Hajj Kiosk Terminals: The Modern Hajj Guide. We wrote a comprehensive research paper that covers our whole idea and we successfully got accepted in the Second Scientific Conference for a poster presentation. It is also worth mentioning that we were the only group who were accepted at such an event from PMU's Boys Section.

The ministry of Higher Education organizing the conference provided us along with the rest of the selected students with free accommodation, transportation, and hospitality for 6 days in Jeddah city. The conference took place in the Hilton Hotel of Jeddah where we attended and presented our project idea on posters. The conference was categorized into Basic Science and Engineering, Health Science, Social Science, and Business. These were presented in either PowerPoint Presentations or Posters of certain size. The conference also introduced different types of Art Work. The opening ceremony was breath-taking. 10000 students were involved, 6000 are female and 4000 are male, but only 500 were participants in the conference. It was quite amazing for us to represent PMU University for the first time as well as representing our own idea to whoever is interested and supportive. We didn't limit ourselves

to presenting our idea, but we also filled our free time at the conference by attending very beneficial presentations from other participants and made contacts with many employees and judges. It is good to remark the presentation of Dr. Walid Fitaihi, the president of the international medical center in Jeddah at the conference. It was heart-breaking for me. We have experienced so much that even we didn't win but at least we had the opportunity to participate and publicize our idea. We were also enlightened to get to know some good friends that shared with us their creative ideas.

My friend and I practiced for our presentation several times before its time. And it was great! We actually repeated it many times whenever a person appeared and asked us questions. The audience was a combination of judges, visitors, and educators. The judges were not known but we were soon able to recognize them easily. They were very impressed with our presentations and our unique idea, all of whom supported and suggested new things to be added to our project. In the end, I would like to thank Mr. Ahmed Hussain for his invaluable support to our group project as well for his massive contribution to the success of our project idea. I cannot also forget Mr. Khalil Osman, the PMU coordinator for his essential guidance of our trip to Jeddah and all the related information about the conference. Last but not the least, I would like to thank and appreciate COE Dean Dr. Jamal's support, and Mr. Omar El Moussa for their invitation to attend the Second Scientific Conference. We are grateful to them for giving us such an opportunity to show our novel idea towards the best of the future by encouraging and supporting students for their creativity innovations, and ideas.
